

## **Amish Cooking from Quilt Country Season One**

### **Program 101 ~ Maple Syrup**

Maple Syrup Season. Marcia makes maple mousse, maple cream pie, maple syrup dumplings, and maple baked ham. Also shown on this program is a segment shot on an Amish farm showing the process of taking sap from maple trees and making it into maple syrup. A friendship quilt was shown at the end of the program from Nappanee, Indiana.

### **Program 102 ~ Fritters Great & Small**

Fritters Great & Small. Marcia makes knee patches, tomato fritters, and apple fritters. The feature in this program dealt with the Shipshewana Auction in Shipshewana, Indiana. Also discussed was the Mennonite Relief Auction in Goshen, Indiana. Artifacts shown include a hickory bentwood rocking chair and a braided hooked rug.

### **Program 103 ~ Breakfast at Dawn**

Breakfast at Dawn. Marcia makes scrapple, tomato gravy served with fried cornmeal mush, homemade graham (grape) nuts, sausage gravy on biscuits, and Indiana farm sausage balls. The feature in this program is morning chores and breakfast on a typical Amish Farm. The quilt was a daisy pattern quilt using the barn door variation.

### **Program 104 ~ Noodle Country**

Noodle country. Marcia makes homemade noodles, fried noodles (a.k.a noodle pancakes), beef and noodles, and onion Rivel soup. The feature showed factory scenes at R & R Homemade Noodles in Millersburg, Ohio. The quilt is a tumbling block quilt from Topeka, Indiana.

### **Program 105 ~ Pies**

Pies. Marcia makes pat-in-pan piecrust, Amish brown sugar pie, hot water pie, buttermilk pie, and bob Andy pie. The feature includes scenes of an Amish kitchen, Green Meadows Ranch Bed and Breakfast, and Shipshewana, Indiana. The quilt is a nine-patch crib quilt found in Wisconsin and brought back to Indiana.

**Program 106 ~ Preserving the Harvest**

Preserving the harvest. Marcia makes yellow tomato preserves, preserved pears with lemon (a.k.a. pear honey), rhubarb conserve, and crock-pot apple butter. The feature includes scenes from Yoder's farm in Sugar Creek, Ohio and Yoder's hardware in Shipshewana, Indiana. Here antique doll quilts were displayed: one patch quilt, a basket variation and a quilt from Topeka, Indiana..

**Program 107 ~ Celebrate the Pig**

Celebrate the Pig. Marcia makes sauerkraut soup, fried apples, roast loin of pork with potatoes & onions, and spareribs and sauerkraut. The feature includes scenes from the offices of "The Budget" weekly newspaper of the Amish & Mennonites, which is circulated, to all of the communities across the country. The artifacts in this program are hand knitted wedding socks, and a black woman's bonnet.

**Program 108 ~ Duck and Chicken in Every Pot**

Duck and Chicken in every pot. Marcia makes barbecued chicken, roast duckling with sauerkraut and apple dressing, oven-fried chicken and jellied chicken. The feature includes scenes from a commercial duck farm, Maple Leaf Farms, Milford, Indiana. The quilt is a piece pattern dating back to 1920 from Holmes Country, Ohio.

**Program 109 ~ The Ripening Garden**

The Ripening Garden. Marcia makes Lorraine potatoes, creamy sautéed tomatoes, and pickled beets with eggs, hot cabbage salad and baked onions with sour cream. The feature includes scenes from Yoder's Amish Home in Millersburg, Ohio and Yoder's Hardware, Shipshewana, Indiana. The quilt is a basket quilt, 1936, Kentucky

**Program 110 ~ Fruits Galore**

Fruits Galore. Marcia makes peach dumplings with custard sauce, apple cake, blackberry roll and Rhubarb sherbet. The feature includes scenes from Kershers' Sunrise Orchards in Goshen, Indiana and Yoder's hardware in Shipshewana, Indiana. The quilt is a four-patch quilt, Wayne County, Ohio.

**Program 111 ~ The Beef is Here**

The Beef is here. Marcia makes mincemeat, country stew, Swiss meatloaf, spicy meat loaf, and roast prime rib of beef. The feature includes scenes from the Shipshewana Auction, Shipshewana, Indiana. Artifacts in this program include two pincushions and a cloth needlepoint case.

### **Program 112 ~ The Blizzard Pantry**

The Blizzard Pantry. Marcia makes tomato dumplings, tomato pudding, steamed bread pudding and large pearl tapioca pudding. The feature includes scenes from Honeyville General Store, the Shipshewana Craft Barn and the Woodlawn Amish Mennonite Church, all in Shipshewana, Indiana. The quilt is a nine-patch quilt.

### **Program 113 ~ Holiday Time**

Holiday time. Marcia makes steamed Christmas pudding with two sauces, Whoopie Pies and Escalloped Oysters. No feature in this program. Artifacts include: children's wooden farm animals and children's antique socks and mittens.

## **Amish Cooking from Quilt Country Season Two**

### **Program 201 ~ The Rites of Spring**

The Rites of Spring. Marcia cooks leg of lamb, asparagus pie, rhubarb dumplings and poppy seed dressing. We also visit a herb garden in Indiana and take a look at an eight-point star quilt.

### **Program 202 ~ Soups On**

Soups On. Marcia fixes country potato soup, cracker ball dumpling soup, beef stock, nine-bean soup and Pennsylvania Dutch sandwiches. The on-location segment is with Suetta, a Mennonite cook who owns and operates a restaurant in Shipshewana, Indiana.

### **Program 203 ~ Rich Harvest**

Rich Harvest. Marcia makes succotash, honey carrots with sweet pickles, pea and spinach salad and zucchini and tomato casserole. The on-location segment is a visit to Cider Press. The quilt is a nine-patch variation.

### **Program 204 ~ How now, brown cow**

How now, brown cow. Marcia makes homemade ice cream and fudge sauce, velvet custard pie, custard cornbread, and rice pudding with lemon sauce. The on-location segment is a visit to a dairy barn and cheese factory. The quilt is a hole-in-the-barn door variation.

**Program 205 ~ By Bread Alone**

By Bread Alone. Marcia bakes German onion cake, Amish dressing, baking powder biscuits and buttermilk bread. The on-location segment is a visit to the Buggy Wheel restaurant to see how bread is made at a Mennonite bakery. There is no quilt shown in this program.

**Program 206 ~ Picnics and Potlucks**

Picnics and Potlucks. Marcia bakes German potato salad, baked beans, pea salad and church supper hamloaf. The on-location segment is a visit to the Hoosier Buggy Shop to see how buggies are made. The owner, Mr. Hostetler, also showed us a couple non-traditional buggies that aren't necessarily used by the Amish.

**Program 207 ~ Our Just Desserts**

Our Just Desserts. Strawberry Shortcake, deep-dish cherry pie, peach cobbler, and old-fashioned apple dumplings are made on this program. The on-location segment is a visit with Rebecca Haarer in Shipshewana who shows us her antique doll collection. We also visit a Mennonite woman in Middlebury, Indiana who makes Amish dolls that are sold commercially in the Shipshewana area. The quilt is a fan pattern from Elkhart, Indiana.

**Program 208 ~ Quilter's Lunch**

Quilter's Lunch. Marcia prepares country fair barbecue sandwiches, chicken corn soup, tuna and cream cheese sandwiches, lemon grape-nut pudding and bran muffins. The on-location segment is at Rebecca Haarer's house where we see her antique dish collection. The quilt is a star and goosefoot variation from Goshen, Indiana.

**Program 209 ~ Cookies, Candies & Other Pleasures**

Cookies, Candies & Other Pleasures. Marcia makes oatmeal-cinnamon crispies, soft sugar cookies, Cracker Jack and coconut chocolate candy. The on-location segment is a visit to a popcorn factory, which processes the popcorn the old-fashioned way. The quilt is a friendship quilt from Honeyville, Indiana.

**Program 210 ~ Amish Pies**

Amish Pies. Marcia prepares pat-in-pan crust, oatmeal pie, pumpkin pie with praline and lemon sponge pie. The on-location segment is a visit to a Mennonite woman's home that speaks to us about pie making while she makes pie. The quilt is a tumbling block crib quilt from Topeka, Indiana.

**Program 211 ~ Amish Cakes**

Amish Cakes. Marcia prepares oatmeal cake, pineapple upside-down cake, carrot cake with cream cheese frosting and cranberry cake with butter sauce. The on-location segment is a visit to New Rinkel flourmill in Howe, Indiana. The quilt is a unique design from La Grange, Indiana.

**Program 212 ~ Elegant Amish**

Elegant Amish. Marcia prepares orange-glazed roast pork, onion patties, date pudding trifle and pumpkin black walnut biscuits. The on-location segment is a visit to a pork packing company in La Grange, Indiana ... Mischler's Meat Packing Company. The quilt is a Goosefoot variation from La Grange, Indiana.

**Program 213 ~ Eclectic Amish**

Eclectic Amish. Marcia prepares a German apple pancake, potato pancakes, German cabbage rolls and cinnamon pudding. The on-location segment is a visit to an Amish house where a dinner is being prepared and served to a group of Mennonite Sunday School adults. The quilt is a rabbit's foot from Coldsprings, California.
